Clerk: Getting ready for the Audit

DPW: Patterson reported the DPW has been busy plowing, cleaning streets and removing snow. There is a leaky relief valve at the filtration plant/ \$5000 to repair \$12000 to replace. No bids have come in on the 41 acres of land for rent. The Ice Rink has been getting a lot of use.

Planning Commission: Leszinske PC representative- PC had questions and concerns regarding Village speed limits and signage. Council request formal complaints. Signage questions were to direct to the Michigan State Police who handles speed signs.

Old Business: Barbara Marczak with Prein & Newhof reported the USDA has approve the loan- The project includes replacing the old north and south lift stations and upgrades to the sewer ponds. The design and engineering phase could start in the fall. The total cost of the engineering is roughly \$156,000 with design about half of this.

New Business: None

Misc: There are concerns that traffic going the wrong way on the one way parking lot between Hometown Pharmacy and Lake Michigan Credit Union. DPW to put one way signs up.
