The Village of Ravenna Planning Commission will review said ordinance/s presented and will enquire/research regarding the ordinances for other cities/villages/townships pros/cons, and Eric will contact other municipalities regarding proposed ordinances for the pros/cons, etc. We'll reconvene in August to discuss this matter/vote.
