The regular meeting of the Village Council was called to order by President Steve Dohm with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 PM at the Village of Ravenna meeting room at 12090 Crockery Creek Drive.

Plescher moved **Boersema** supported to approve the July 6th Regular meeting minutes as presented. Motion Carried 3/0

Boersema moved **Plescher** supported to approve the August 3rd agenda as presented. Motion Carried 3/0

Public Comments: **Paul Wetmore** of the Ravenna First Reform Church was present asking to have a Community Gospel Concert at Conklin Park on Saturday, September 18th 2021 from 5-8pm.

Boersema moved **Plescher** supported to approve the request from the Ravenna Pub to have a beer tent, Friday, August 20th. The hours of operation to be 6:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. The music will quit playing at midnight (12:00 a.m.). Closing the alley by 4:30 on Friday until tent is removed on Saturday. Pub will provide her own security. Lions will receive half the gate money or \$500 whichever is more. Motion carried. 3/0

TREASURER REPORTED: One Shut off was performed in July. Treasurer 90-day review was good!!

DPW: G Nelson reported that DPW have been doing shoulder work. Ordered bottles for Lead N Copper testing due Sept 30th. Edge parks, painted bathrooms and ice rink. Crockery Creek Drive milling has been rescheduled will begin on the 5th of August with the paving scheduled for Monday the 9th of August.
