The regular **Ravenna Village Council** meeting was called to order by President Steve Dohm at 7:00 PM with the pledge of allegiance. Public Comments: Ryan and Aaron with Badger Meter Company gave a presentation to the council on their electric water metering system which is cloud based to be considered by the council.

Clerk: Prepared and submitted the Coronavirus Relief Local Government Grant. The new North Lift Station changeover will be on Wednesday the 7th of October with the possibility of the South Lift Station change over as early as next week. Water filtration plant is in need of some maintenance which will run around \$3000 along with purchasing a Iron Test Kit \$213.18.
